Devotional 1: Love Begins With God

Scripture:

“We love because He first loved us.” — 1 John 4:19

Devotional Thought:

God’s love is the starting point of all love. Before you ever reached for Him, He reached for you. His love is unconditional, unwavering, and unearned.

Reflection Questions:

- **Where do you need to receive God’s love again**
- **What lies have you believed about God’s love that need replacing with truth**

Prayer:

Lord, help me rest in Your love today. Let me feel the depth of Your affection for me.

Devotional 2: Love Is a Daily Choice

Scripture:

“Let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.” — 1 John 3:18

Devotional Thought:

Love is intentional. It shows up in how we speak, serve, forgive, and respond. Every day offers opportunities to choose love over irritation, compassion over judgment, and patience over frustration.

Reflection Questions:

- What is one intentional act of love I can offer today**
- Who in my life needs grace from me right now**

Prayer:

Father, teach me to love in action and truth.

Devotional 3: Love Stretches Us Into Christlikeness

Scripture:

“Love is patient, love is kind...” — 1
Corinthians 13:4–7

Devotional Thought:

This passage is not a romantic poem — it is a spiritual blueprint. Love stretches us, challenges us, and shapes us into the image of Christ.

Reflection Questions:

- Which part of this passage challenges me the most
- How can I practice patience or kindness today

Prayer:

Lord, stretch me into the kind of love that reflects You.

Devotional 4: Love Heals and Restores

Scripture:

“Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins.” — 1

Peter 4:8

Devotional Thought:

Love doesn't erase the past, but it creates space for healing. When we choose love, we choose restoration over resentment.

Reflection Questions:

- **What relationship needs healing**
 - **What step can I take toward reconciliation**

Prayer:

God, let Your healing love flow through me

Devotional 5: Love Is the Mark of a True Disciple

Scripture:

“By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.” —

John 13:35

Devotional Thought:

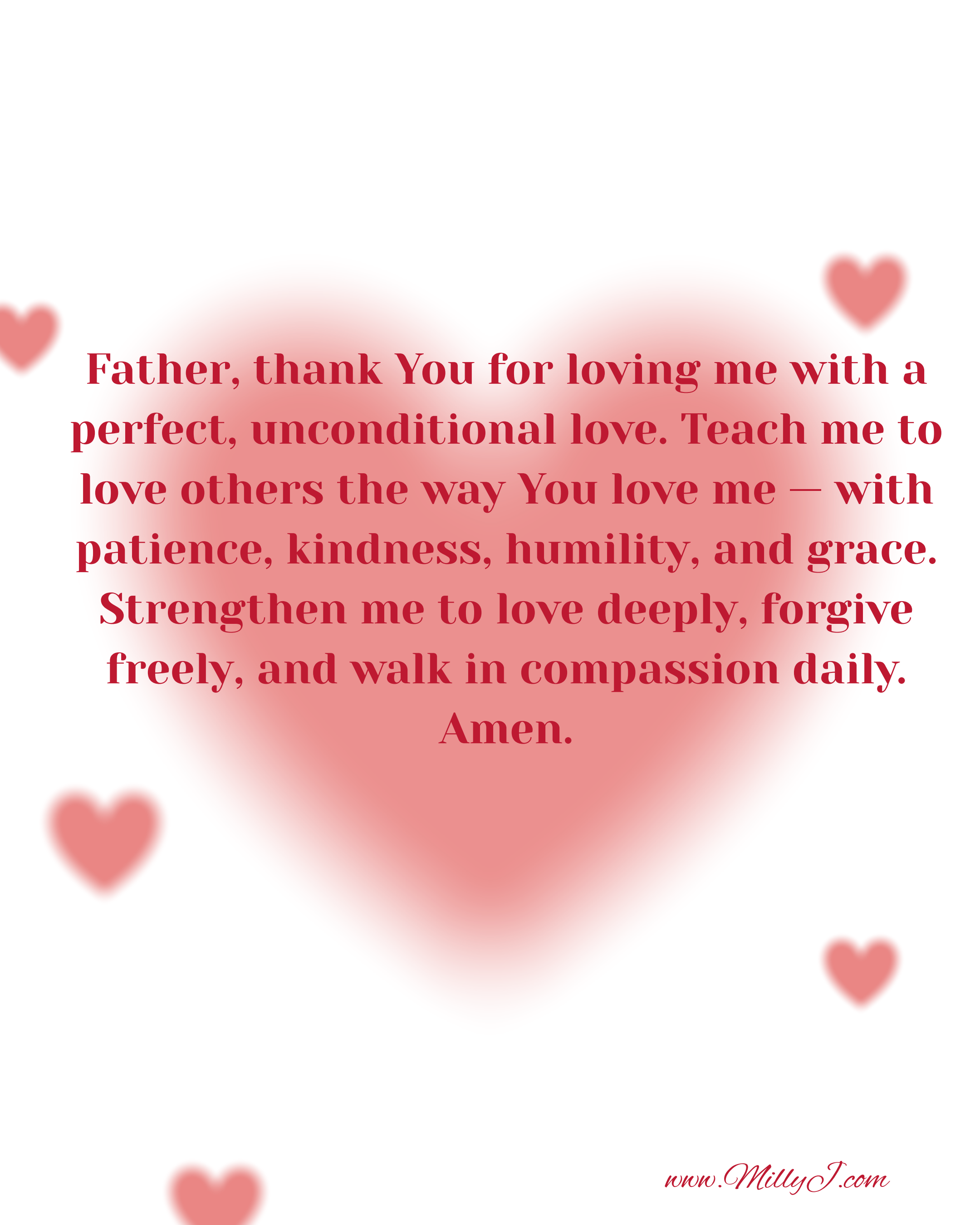
Love is the evidence of our faith. When we love well, we reveal God to the world.
